DIRT TRACK TRUCK SERIES FULFILLS MONTPELIER'S GOAL OF GRASSROOTS RACING

Eight Stops Planned for Trucks in 2022

MONTPELIER, IN (March 3) – With a commitment to showcase grassroots level racing, officials from Montpelier Motor Speedway have aligned with Andy King and his regional Dirt Track Truck Series for eight events in 2022.

“We fully feel that our niche in racing is to provide a home for entry-level type racing,” commented Montpelier’s promoter Larry Boos. “Andy’s series for the dirt Trucks fits right into that goal. and we look forward to the competitive action they bring to the plate.”

“With such a diverse schedule between 7 different tracks this year, the Dirt Track Truck Series is excited to run 8 or our 20 races at Montpelier Motor Speedway” stated King who is the owner and promoter of the group. “This provides our travelling racers with a real home track feeling within the points chase.”

Montpelier’s basic program on the Northeastern Indiana clay oval will feature the UMP Modified, Super Stock, Street Stock and the Affolder Implement Hornet divisions as the standard fare, while the Dirt Track Truck Series and USAC Speed D2 Midwest Thunder Midgets will make frequent stops.

As Montpelier slowly expands into special event racing, the Buckeye Outlaw Sprint Series (BOSS) invades April 23 and the grueling UMP Summer Nationals for Late Models and Modifieds makes a mid-week stop on July 13.

Following a pre-season tune and test session April 9, the Montpelier season swings into action Saturday, April 16 with a twilight show.
